

GDPR REFLECTIONS – PUTTING THEORY INTO PRACTICE

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came in to force over a year ago, and with it came increased public awareness of the rights that people have around how their data can be handled. With that in mind, organisations can't afford to operate in a non-compliant way, but the GDPR is a complex piece of legislation and putting theory in to practice isn't always easy.

This short training session will be delivered by Anna Bezodis from Anna Bezodis Training and Consultancy, and will provide participants with:

- an overview of key aspects of the GDPR
- a round-up of real-life cases that have been dealt with under the new legislation, and lessons we can learn from them
