Un o'r uchafbwyntiau oedd ein cynhadledd trydydd sector lle roedd dros 160 o gyfranogwyr.

Roedd y digwyddiad yn bosibl oherwydd cyllid gan Lywodraeth y DU drwy Gronfa Ffyniant Gyffredin y DU, oedd hefyd wedi cyllido ein Cronfa Allweddol o £800,000 tuag at Meithrin Gallu yn y sector.

Cyfrannodd hyn at y flwyddyn uchaf erioed o gyllid a ddyfarnwyd gan CCGC - £2,691,889.43

The year ending March 2024 was the first since I was appointed as Chief Officer.

One of the highlights was our third sector conference where there were over 160 participants.

The event was made possible by funding from the UK Government through the UK's Shared Prosperity Fund, which also funded our Key Fund of £800,000 towards Capacity Building in the sector.

This contributed to a record year of funding awarded by CVSC - £2,691,889.43

Astudiaeth Achos - grant dan arweiniad ieuencid

Case Study - Youth led grant

The Youth Led Grant is a scheme that is special to CVSC. Every year, organisations apply to the Youth Led Grant to fund projects that are aimed at young people in Conwy, and the decisions are made by young people from Conwy themselves.



"I have really enjoyed making new friends and helping out in the community. I think the Youth Led Panel is really important for young people in the local area as it makes a difference having young people deciding where the money should go to help and improve facilities and opportunities for the young people. Being on the panel has helped me with my teamwork skills but also my confidence as sharing my voice and opinions with others is a really important part of the panel". - Our panel member, Megan

Astudiaeth Achos - Cronfa Fferm Wynt Coedwig Clocaenog

Ym mis Rhagfyr 2022 dyfarnwyd £9,920 i Making Sense CIO tuag at eu prosiect Dwylo Bach yn Llanrwst.

Mae Dwylo Bach yn raglen greadigol a deniadol o weithgareddau ar gyfer plant y blynnyddoedd cynnar a'u rhieni/gofalwyr.

Cymerodd cyfanswm o 276 o blant 0-4 oed a 181 o oedolion ran yn eu sesiynau yn Llanrwst. Buont hefyd yn darparu sesiynau wedi'u teilwra ar gyfer 3 busnes gwarchod plant, 2 gylch ti a Fi a STAND Gogledd Cymru – cyfanswm o 6 grŵp gyda 12 aelod o staff yn cymryd rhan yn y sesiynau.

Case Study - Clocaenog Forest Wind Farm Fund

In December 2022 Making Sense CIO were awarded £9,920 towards their project Dwylo Bach in Llanrwst. 'Dwylo Bach' is a creative and engaging programme of activities for early years children and their parents/carers.

A total of 276 children aged 0-4 and 181 adults engaged with their sessions at Llanrwst. They also provided tailored sessions for 3 childminding businesses, 2 Cylch ti a Fi groups and STAND North Wales – 6 groups in total with 12 members of staff participating in the sessions.

Astudiaeth Achos - Cronfa Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Gwynt y Mor a Cronfa Cymunedol Gwastadau Rhyl

Y llynedd, derbyniodd Festival Church Towyn arian Gwynt y Môr fel rhan o'u datblygiad graddol i uwchraddio'r eglwys ar gyfer y gymuned. Galluogodd y cyllid y gwaith o adnewyddu eu cegin.

Mae'r gegin newydd hefyd wedi galluogi nifer o'n grwpiau cymunedol i ailddechrau yn yr adeilad, yn enwedig ein clwb cinio wythnosol (a arferai gael ei alw'n 'Soups' ond sydd bellach wedi'i ail-lansio fel 'Oasis') sy'n darparu cinio wedi'i baratoi'n ffres a lle i bobl dod at ein gilydd a chymdeithasu.

Case Study - Gwynt y Mor Community Fund & Rhyl Flats Community Fund

Last year, Festival Church Towyn received Gwynt y Mor funding as part of their phased development to upgrade the church for the community. The funding enabled the refurbishment of their kitchen.

The new kitchen has also enabled a number of our community groups to restart in the building, especially our weekly luncheon club (used to be called 'Soups' but now relaunched as 'Oasis') that provides freshly prepared lunches and a place for people to come together and socialise.

Gwirfoddoli Volunteering

Mae Amdani! Conwy yn brosiect newydd mewn partneriaeth â Chyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy a Chelfyddydau Anabledd Cymru sy'n cefnogi lleoliadau diwylliannol a threfnwyr digwyddiadau ac yn gweithio gyda'n cymunedau i wneud y celfyddydau, diwylliant a threftadaeth yn hwyl, yn hygrych ac yn gynhwysol. Mae Amdani! Conwy yn creu cyfleoedd gwirfoddoli i bobl leol gymryd rhan yn y celfyddydau, diwylliant a threftadaeth. Gall unrhyw un sydd â diddordeb yn y celfyddydau, diwylliant a threftadaeth ymuno!

Conwy is a project in partnership with Conwy County Borough Council and Disability Arts Cymru which supports cultural venues and event organisers and works with our communities to make arts, culture and heritage fun, accessible and inclusive. Amdani! Conwy creates volunteering opportunities for local people to get involved in arts, culture and heritage. Anyone with an interest in arts, culture, and heritage can join!

Governance



Support and guidance for community groups and organisations to meet good practice has remained a key priority for the CVSC Team.


We have worked with many groups seeking to strengthen their governance structures, including by adopting more robust constitutions and considering incorporation.
